**Cain offering fruit of the
(cursed) ground was a
willful rejection of the divine revelation
that shedding of blood was needed.**

**The revelation that blood was needed
was revealed to his parents
and would have grown
as plain as their clothes to him.**

**He was held accountable for the truth
he received from them.**

**If he had personally tested those
“it takes shedding of blood”
truths he would have found
“acceptance” of God as Abel did.**

**He learned the hard way that the gospel
– sufficient for his parents – was more
than something to inherit.**

How did the sacrificers know that their offerings were respected or not?

Gen. 4:3 - 5

Other OT places accepted by fire from heaven.

Holy Spirit falls in answer to blood of Christ.



A person is accepted or rejected according to his following the plan of blood.

A second chance.

7 If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door.

And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.

Results of rejection of blood plan

6 And the LORD said unto Cain,
Why art thou wroth? and why is thy
countenance fallen?

Left struggling over lack of acceptance of God

– first anger in the Bible was over finding
out one didn't give properly.

Results of continued rejection of blood plan

Pursued by Satan (...and if thou doest not well,
sin lieth at the door.)

**But God's plan remains the source of
victory over even that.**

Warning - Sibling Rivalry in the household of faith

Could it have been that the reason Cain was holding back from making a blood sacrifice was because he would have to get the animal from his brother?

8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.

Spilt Blood Cries Out

9 And the LORD said unto Cain,
Where [is] Abel thy brother?

And he said, I know not:
[Am] I my brother's keeper?

10 And he said, What hast thou done?
the voice of thy brother's blood
crieth unto me from the ground.

Christ's Shed Blood Speaks

Hebs. 12:24 And to Jesus the mediator
of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling,
that speaketh better things than [that of] Abel.

Lk. 11:50 That the blood of all the prophets, which was shed from the Foundation of the world, may be required of this generation;

51 From the blood of Abel unto the blood of Zacharias, which perished between the altar and the temple: verily I say unto you, It shall be required of this generation.

Spilt blood speaks - Abel

Hebs. 11:4 By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.

Speaketh what?

- Of the Lamb to come in the offering of his firstlings**
- Of persecution that would come due to the blood plan in his own blood being shed.**

The end of the story on the rejection of the blood plan

Gen. 4:11 And now art thou cursed from the earth, which hath opened her mouth to receive thy brother's blood from thy hand;

12 When thou tillest the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto thee her strength; a fugitive and a vagabond shalt thou be in the earth.


