Lost all his cattle. His seven sons and three daughters
died in a windstrom near the beginning of his calamities.
No sacrifices from chapters 2 – 42.
No cattle. Nothing to make blood sacrifices with.



42:8 Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to my servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and my servant Job shall pray for you: for him will I accept:...



10 And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.

13 He had also seven sons and three daughters.

This is in keeping with twice as much because he must not have really lost the first ones.

The enemy must not be able to break the hedge of our eternal standing with God.

Even though he can take the life he can't take the soul. We have to break that hedge from the inside.



Eccl. 10:8 He that diggeth a pit shall fall into it;
and whoso breaketh an hedge, a serpent shall bite him.

Prov. 25:28 He that hath no rule over his own
spirit is like a city that is broken down, and without walls.

Today our hedge is kept from within with
the sprinkling from an open fountain of blood.



The Open Fountain

Zech. 13:1 In that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.

Jn. 12:27 Now is my soul troubled;
and what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour:
but for this cause came I unto this hour.

28 Father, glorify thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, saying, I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again.

Acts. 2:23 Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God...



The **fountain of His blood** was opened
5 Ways by four different tools.

To what benefit?

➤ **Roman Scourging**

1. His back – Why? By his stripes we are healed.

Ps. 129:3 The plowers plowed upon my back:
they made long their furrows.

Is. 50:6 I gave my back to the smitters



➤ **Crown of thorns** – sharply stinging poison resulted in a burning and itching.

2. **His head** – Why? - Comfort against our tormenting thoughts.



➤ Nails

Ps. 22:16 They have pierced my hands and feet

3. - Hands

4. - Feet

- Surrender to his nailing sins

Col. 2:14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;



➤ **Spear**

5. His side – Flow of blood and water

Jn. 19:34 But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water.
