Justification

- Justification – to make valid, to absolve, to vindicate, to set right
- The act of being declared free from sin judicially
- Jesus makes us free from the guilt and punishment of sin by dying on the cross (Jesus is our scapegoat)
- Remember God always loves us but God also does not like sin
- Rom. 3:26; 4:7 -8
- Gal. 3:11-14

[Sanctification]

- This is the process of becoming more like Christ (means separation, setting apart)
- Rom. 6:22
- 2 Thess. 2:13
- 2 Tim. 2:21
- 1 John 3:2 -10

[Glorification]

- This is being eternally freed from the sin struggle
- Romans 8:17, 18, 30
- 1 Thess. 4:13 - 18
- 1 Cor. 4:16 - 18
