

How to Partake of the Lamb

Ex. 11:5

10th Plague - Death of every first born
human and beast

v. 6 “there shall be a great cry throughout
the land greater than before or since”

Only possible protection was the Blood of the Lamb

- 12:3 Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:
- 4 And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbour next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb.

Share It

- 12: 3 & 4 - Lamb per house - any extra share with “his neighbor next unto his house”

Don't Walk On the Blood

- v. 7 “Strike it on side posts and on the upper door post”
... but not on floor

Hebs. 10:28 Anyone who rejected the law of Moses died without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. 29 How much more severely do you think a man deserves to be punished who has trampled the Son of God under foot, who has treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant that sanctified him, and who has insulted the Spirit of grace?

Must eat the lamb and eat it with only unleavened bread

- v. 8 That same night they are to eat the meat roasted over the fire, along with bitter herbs, and bread made without yeast.

Jn. 6:53 Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you.

Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.

For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink.

Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in him.

59 He said this while teaching in the synagogue in Capernaum.

60 On hearing it, many of his disciples said, "This is a hard teaching. Who can accept it?"

66 From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him.

Eat the lamb with unleaven bread only

- Ex. 11:8 That same night they are to eat the meat roasted over the fire, along with bitter herbs, and bread made without yeast

1 Cor. 5:6 Your glorying [is] not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump? 7 Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us: 8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth

Eat only fresh lamb

- 10 And ye shall let nothing of it remain until the morning; and that which remaineth of it until the morning ye shall burn with fire.

Eat it with a readiness for service

- 11 And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand;

Get all of His passover you can

- and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the LORD'S passover. **Eat it with a readiness for service**

Stay under the blood until judgment passes

- v. 22 And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip [it] in the blood that [is] in the bason, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the blood that [is] in the bason; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning.

1 Jn. 2:28 And now, little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming.

Expect miracles and strength to happen when you eat the lamb

- Ps. 105: 37 He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and there was not one feeble person among their tribes.
