<sup>2</sup>Be not forgetful to entertain strangers:  
for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

<sup>3</sup>Remember them that are in bonds,  
as bound with them; and them which suffer adversity,  
as being yourselves also in the body.

<sup>4</sup>Marriage is honourable in all...

Honour – esteem worthy, precious or great price

<sup>5</sup>Let your conversation be without covetousness;  
and be content with such things as ye have:  
for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

<sup>6</sup>So that we may boldly say,  
The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear  
what man shall do unto me.

1 Peter 1:7 Likewise, ye husbands,  
**dwell with them** according to knowledge,  
**giving honour unto** the wife,  
as unto the weaker vessel,  
and as **being heirs together of the grace of life;**  
that your prayers be not hindered.



## *Not just for Marriage*

1 Peter 1:8

Finally, be ye all of one mind,  
having compassion one of another,  
love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous:

<sup>9</sup>Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing:  
but **contrariwise blessing;**  
**knowing that ye are thereunto called,**  
**that ye should inherit a blessing.**

<sup>10</sup>For he that will love life, and see good days,  
let him **refrain his tongue from evil,**  
**and his lips that they speak no guile:**

<sup>11</sup>Let him **eschew evil, and do good;**  
**let him seek peace, and ensue it.**

<sup>12</sup>For the **eyes of the Lord are over the righteous,**  
**and his ears are open unto their prayers:**  
**but the face of the Lord is against them that do**  
**evil.**

*Evil here is the mal-treatment of others*



Mt. 4:15 But speaking the truth in love,  
may grow up into him in all things,  
which is the head, even Christ:

Eph. 4:26 Be ye angry, and sin not:  
let not the sun go down upon your wrath:

**27Neither give place to the devil.**

To keep from giving place to the devil  
– deal with anger in relationships...

•<sup>29</sup>Let no corrupt communication  
proceed out of your mouth,  
but **that which is good to the use of edifying,**  
**that it may minister grace unto the hearers.**
