# To Be A Savior

- Willing to Rescue
- Able to Rescue

Can't be rescued by someone  
else that is going under

Christ is our sinless savior.

But rather, by someone  
who has mastered the water  
and is in control

# We have a different Savior

How do you mean?

He stands on a higher ground than us, and does more than

- join us as a better swimmer,
- point to shore,
- command us to swim harder,
- teach swimming lessons, etc.

Christ is our very capable and willing savior.

# Sinless Jesus who came to Save

2 Cor. 5:21

For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Don't strip Him of His difference or you have nothing different to believe in.

# Where is the Difference in Your Savior?

## 1. Virgin Birth

The more we know of Christ, the more reasonable His virgin conception becomes.

To base your religion on a denied virgin birth is to base it on what you believe God cannot do

# A Virgin Birth Savior

The virgin birth proves Christ is a capable savior, and that our God is wanting to save - since He provides the sinless sacrifice.

*A savior must be able and willing.*

If Christ was not of virgin birth in God reaching out to save, we have no different of a savior.

The virgin birth preserves His sinlessness –  
being on a higher ground – A God capable  
of saving

He has mastered the waters, and is in  
control; a capable savior.

- He had to be sinless to have the perfection God demands of the saving sacrifice.
- Through virgin birth God provided the very sacrifice He demanded.

A sinless man in the moral realm is as great of a miracle as a virgin birth in the biological realm.

Hebs. 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

26 For such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens;

27 Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself.

- He has the salvation and holiness we lack
- We need a savior, He does not
- He is the perfect sacrifice – so needed to be offered only once

Christ has the credentials of the only  
capable savior. He is sinless in virgin birth  
- God reaching to drowning man.

Many lifeguards, but only one savior.
