This past Wednesday to Friday Pastor Poitras was in our nation's capital attending a **Canada Conference** of ministers of our faith. Here are some nuggets he picked up from some of the teaching sessions;

- Unbelief puts our circumstance between us and God. Faith puts God between us and our circumstance.
- 80% of marriages that have been struck by adultery actually recuperate, as the couples choose to deal with the root issues.
- Healthy families are so because they talk, touch and trust
- Brother is not spelt c-l-o-n-e
- On the phone – men “fix” and hang up. Women call to “share”.
- One out of 5 things you are involved in your work carries 80% of your value. Focus on what makes you valuable.
- To fully talk about the great need of Christian missions you would have to use the following 4 words – Asian, Islamic, Urban and Young
- Only 7% of recovery from anything of mental anguish happens by medication. 9% recover if they are just left to heal over time. But, over 80% heal if they have spiritual influence.
- It is well proven that there is no inward healing to be found without the help of people that become like family.
- Prophets represent God to people and represent people to God.
