

Welcome to Bethel Church – March 14, 2010

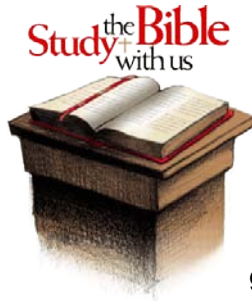
